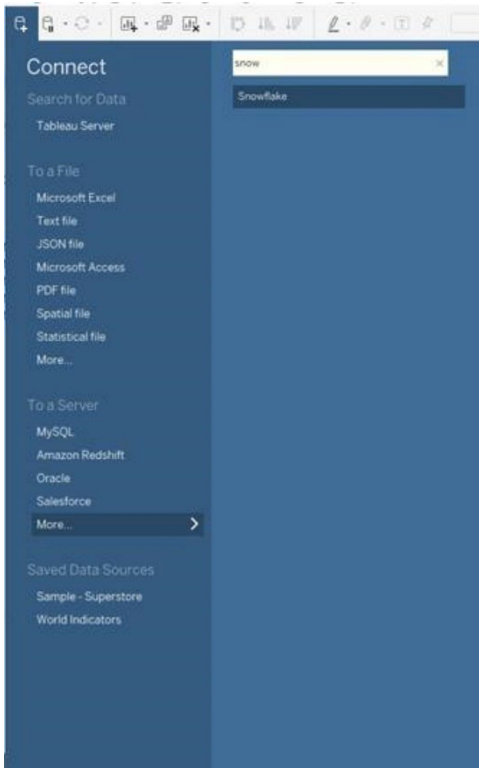



Tableau Snowflake Integration

1. Open Tableau
2. Click Connect to data.
3. Select “More” under “To a Server”. Search for “Snowflake”



4. Input your Snowflake credentials
