- **Direct Patient Care Physician Supply Trends**: this graph shows the trends over time of the Supply Ratios (the number per 100,000 population). [Direct Patient Care includes Primary Care and Specialists]
- **Direct Patient Care Physicians by Age and Gender – 2011**: this graph shows the percentage of male and female Direct Patient Care Physicians by age, and a text box contains the median ages for male and female Direct Patient Care Physicians.
- **Direct Patient Care Physicians by Race/Ethnicity and Location – 2011**: this graph shows the percentage of Direct Patient Care Physicians by Race/Ethnicity, broken out by Rural and Urban locations.
- **Primary Care Physician Supply Trends**: this graph shows the trends over time of the Supply Ratios (the number per 100,000 population).
- **Primary Care Physicians by Gender and Location – 2011**: this graph shows the percent of Primary Care Physicians by gender for Rural and Urban areas.

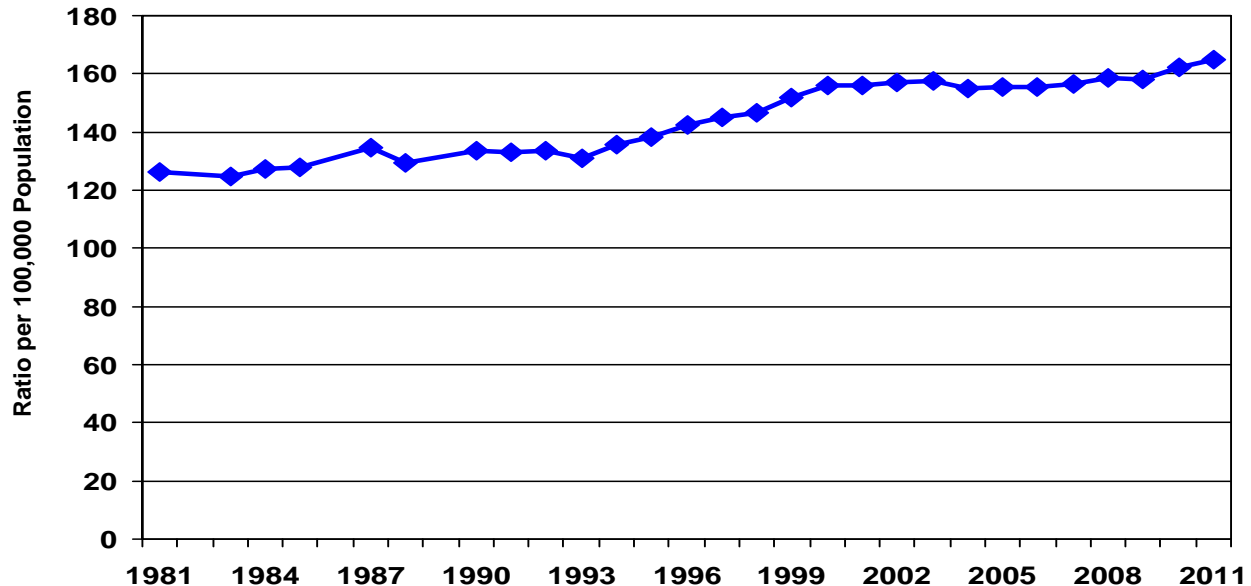

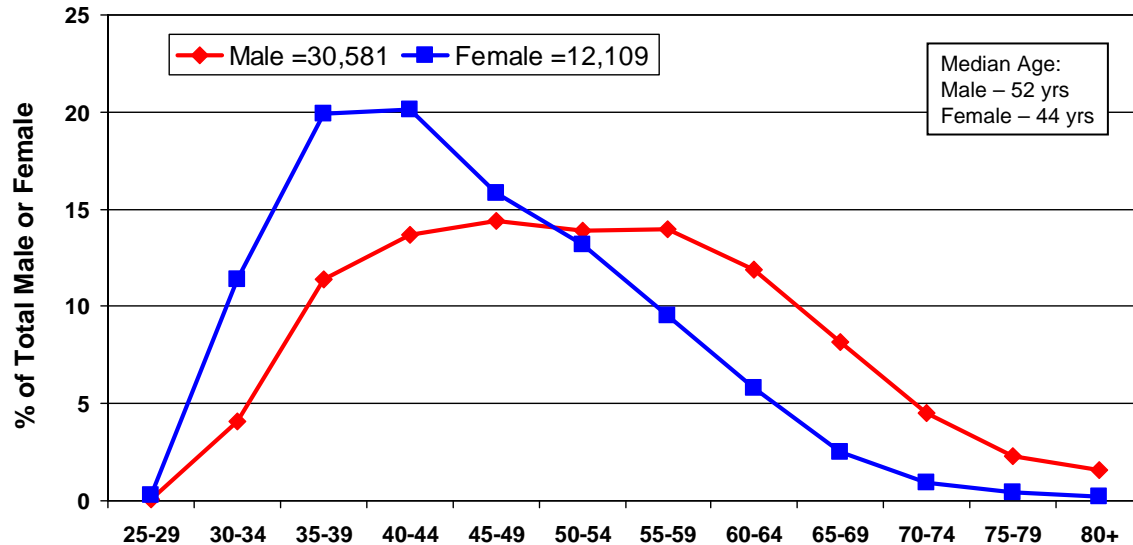

# Direct Patient Care Physicians by Age and Gender – 2011

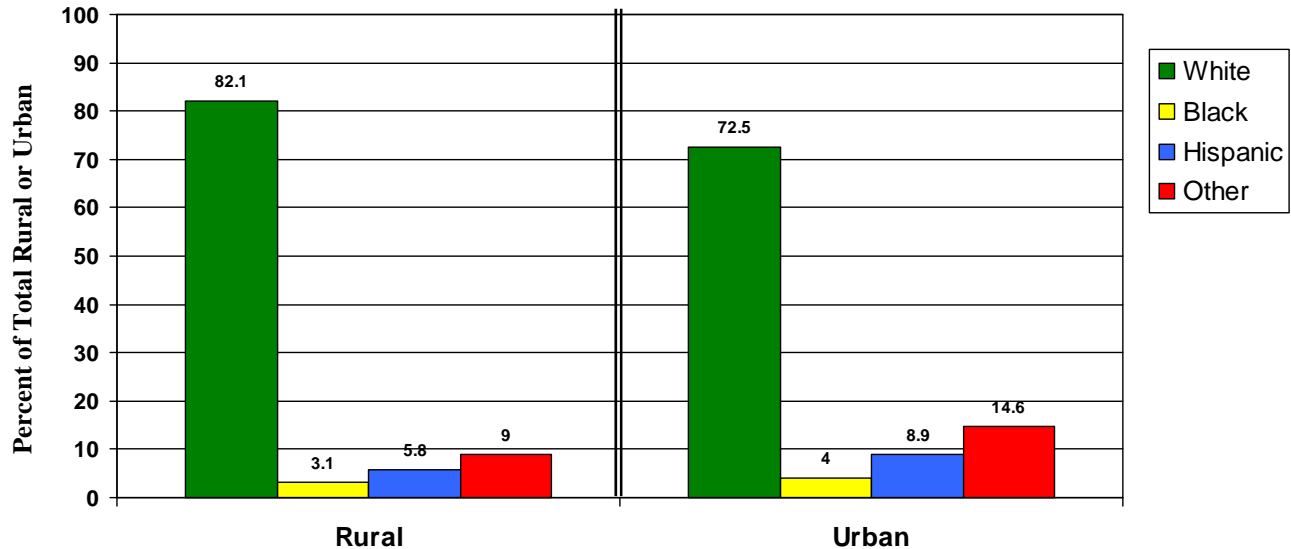

# Direct Patient Care Physicians by Race/Ethnicity and Location – 2011

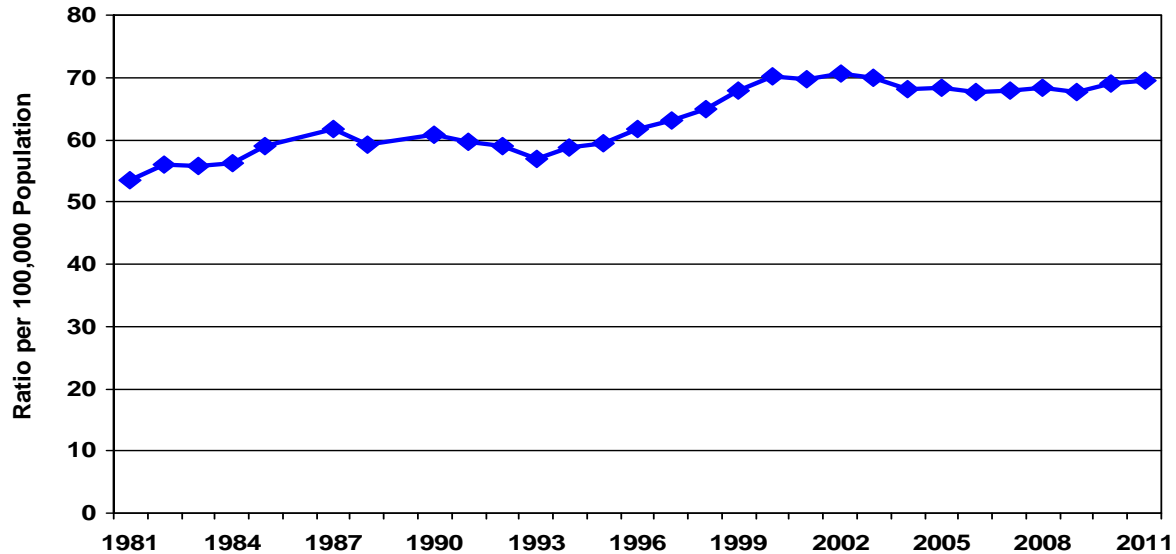

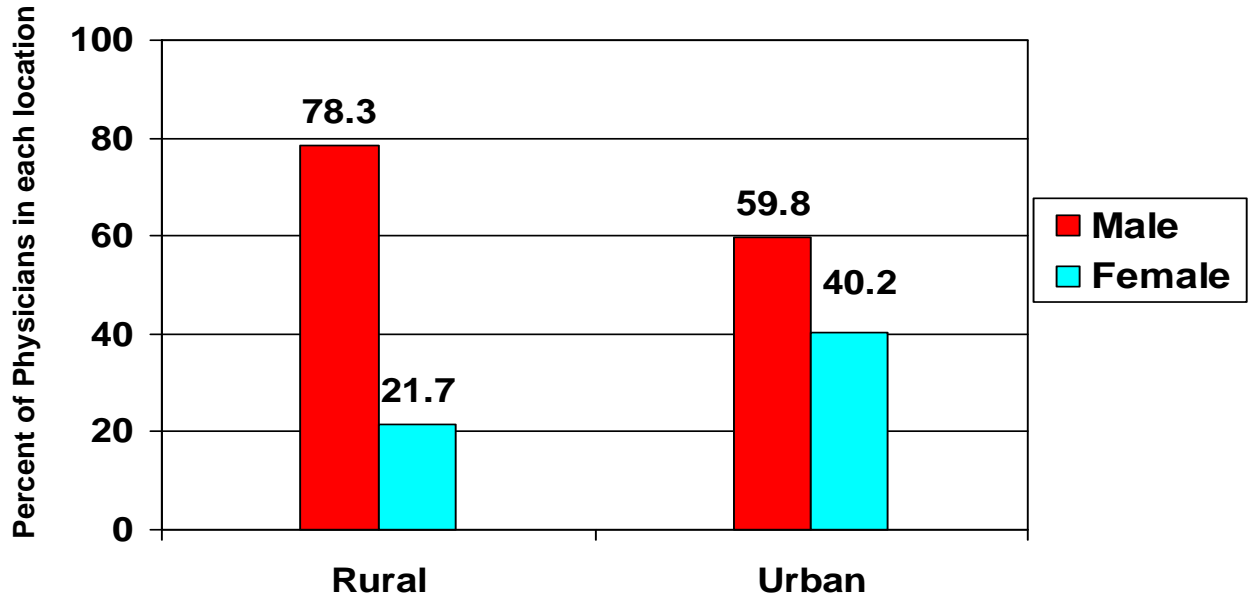

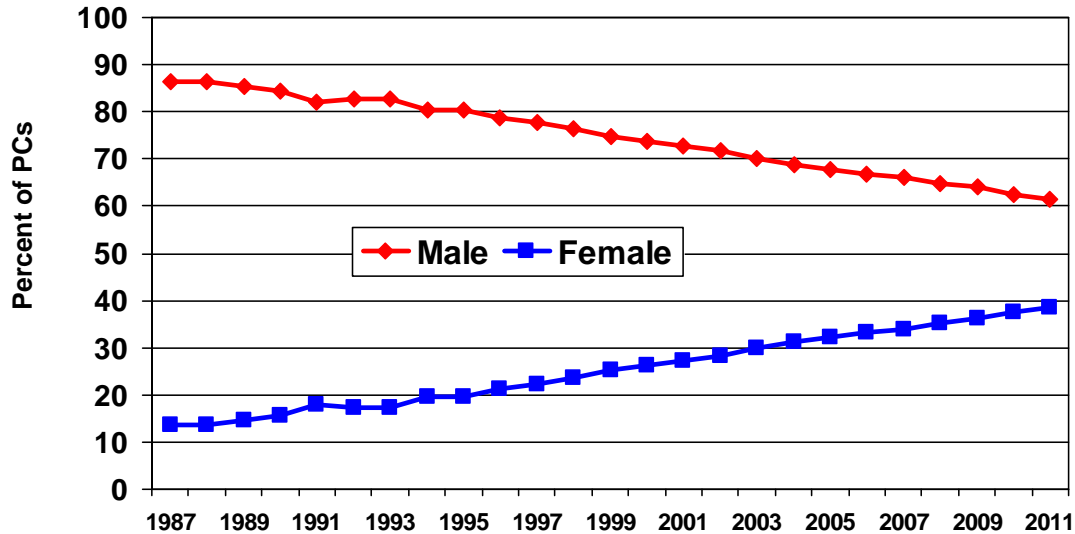

# Primary Care Physicians by Gender and Location - 2011



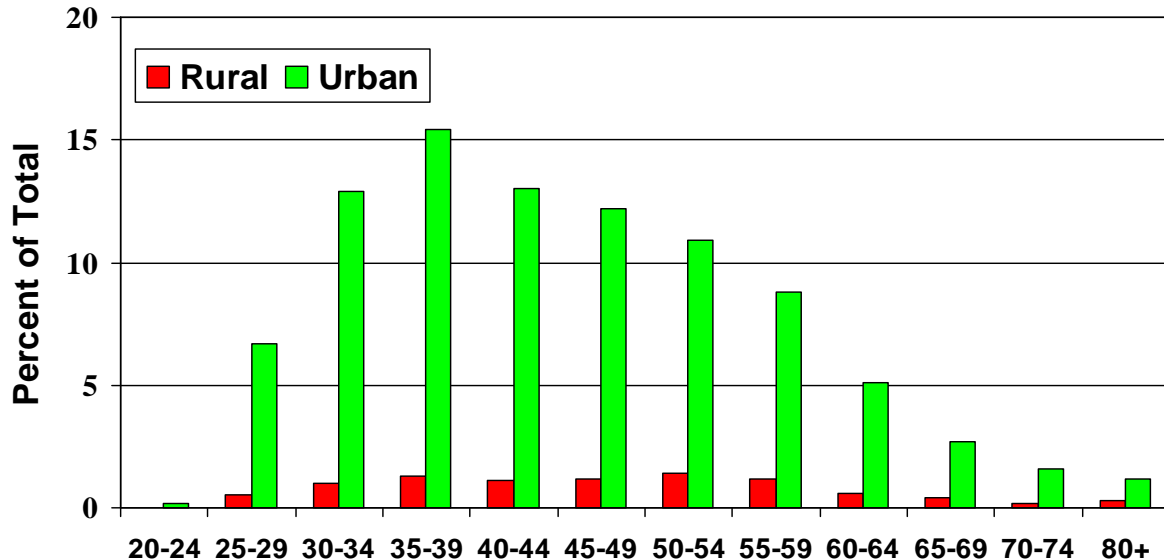

# Primary Care Physician Trends by Gender



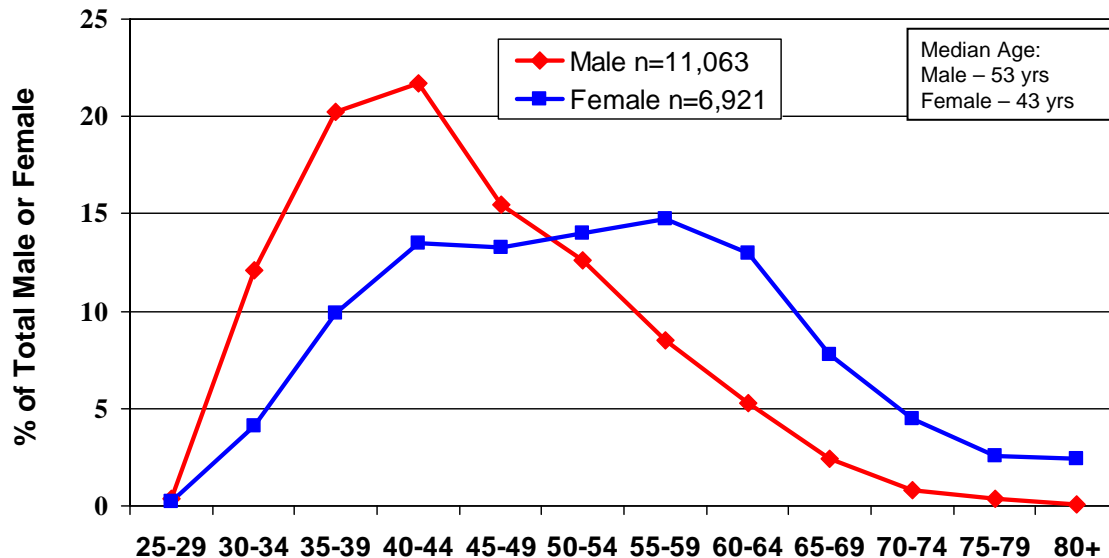

# Primary Care Physicians by Age and Location - 2011



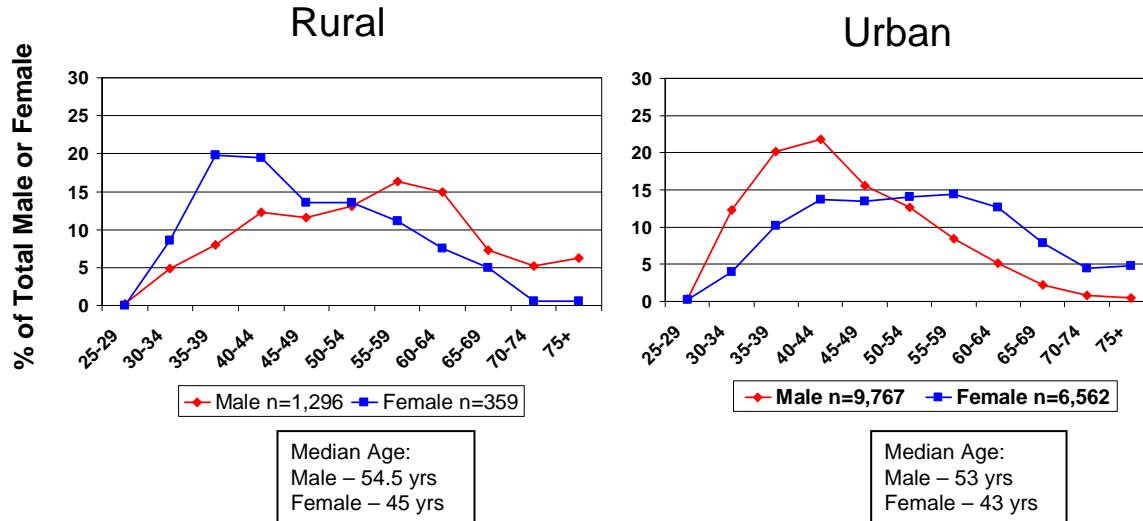

# Primary Care Physicians by Age and Gender - 2010



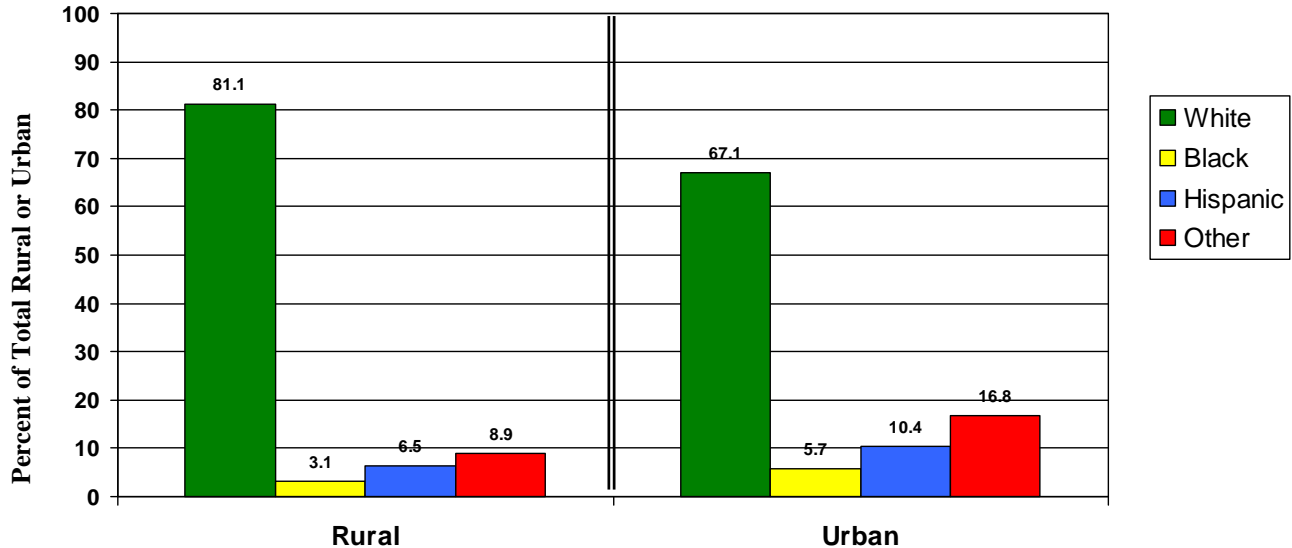

# Primary Care Physicians by Race/Ethnicity and Location – 2011

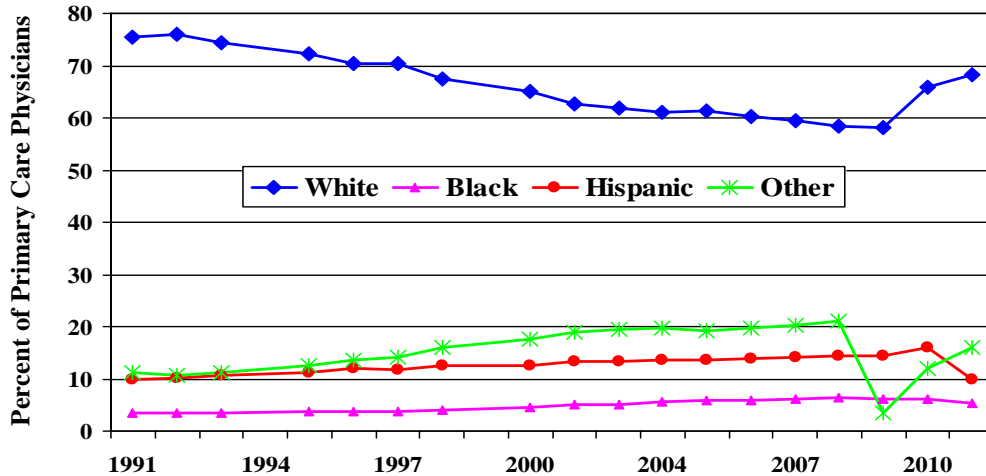

# Primary Care Physician Trends by Race/Ethnicity



Due to the transition to the Minimum Data Set collection method, more than 18% of the race data were missing in 2009, and 6.7% were missing in 2010. This had a disproportionate effect on the number who identified themselves as “Other” for those years.
