Psychologists Graph Documentation

- Note: A Psychologist may hold more than one type of license, and therefore may be included in more than one of the specific license type graphs. The All Psychologists (unduplicated) graphs shows the total supply of licensees for that year; however, duplicate records (for example a person who both a Licensed Psychologist and a Licensed Specialist in School Psychology) have been removed, so each licensee is counted only once. The All Psychologists graph best represents the total supply of Psychologists; however, the scope of practice is different for the different license types, and one of the more specific graphs may be more appropriate to use, depending on for what use the data are intended.
- <u>All Psychologists (unduplicated) Supply Trends</u>: this graph shows the trends over time of the Supply Ratios (the number per 100,000 population).

- **Provisionally Licensed Psychologists Supply Trends**: this graph shows the trends over time of the Supply Ratios (the number per 100,000 population).










Licensed Psychological Associate Supply Trends


