

# Remember the 4th DTaP at 15-18 months

## Every Vaccine Counts!

Vaccines build your child's health just like building blocks can make a wall or a tower. One by one they help strengthen your child's immunity against deadly diseases. But your child can't do it alone. In order to build your child's immunity it's important he or she receives all of his or her vaccines according to the Recommended Immunization Schedule. One of the most frequently missed vaccines is the 4th DTaP vaccine. The 4th DTaP protects your child against diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis (whooping cough). It is due at 15 to 18 months of age and often requires a special visit to the doctor in order to receive it on schedule. Talk to your child's doctor about getting all your child's vaccines on time, every time!

Birth	HepB
2 months	HepB, DTaP, Hib, IPV, PCV7, Rotavirus
4 months	DTaP, Hib, IPV, PCV7, Rotavirus
6 months	HepB, DTaP, Hib, IPV, PCV7, Rotavirus, Influenza
12 months	Hib, PCV7, Varicella, MMR, HepA
15-18 months	DTaP
18 months	HepA
4-6 years	DTaP, IPV, MMR, Varicella
11-12 years	Tdap, MCV4, HPV
