


Skills and experiences you may have developed through your degree include:

Examples of Entry-Level Job Postings (with Texas DSHS)

- Public Health and Prevention Specialist I or II
 - Provide education to the community on preventing chronic disease
- Program Specialist I or II
 - Conduct coalition building and program planning work for a DSHS initiative
- Community Health Specialist
 - Identify health care needs in a community and provide education
- Customer Service Representative
 - Communicate with partners regarding a DSHS service (e.g., Vital Statistics, Immunization Information Services) and keep records related to this program
