

Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting Arbovirus Activity, Week 49






Figure 3. Human Cases of West Nile Virus Reported in Texas, by MMWR Week of Onset, 2019-2021, Week 49 14 12 -Number of Reported Cases 2019 2020 2021 2 36 4 4 4 4 4 **MMWR Week of Onset**
