

Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting Arbovirus Activity, Week 50






Figure 3. Human Cases of West Nile Virus Reported in Texas, by MMWR Week of Onset, 2019-2021, Week 50 12 -Number of Reported Cases 36 0 4 4 4 4 4 8 8 **MMWR Week of Onset**
