Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting Arbovirus Activity, Week 1-29




Figure 2. Epidemiologic Curve of Mosquito WNV Activity, 2016-2018




Figure 3. Epidemiologic Curve of Human WNV Activity, 2016-2018
