


Google Chrome

This app allows you to store contact information of your clinical team.





This app will automatically store videos taken.




Emocha


Messaging

This app allows you This app allows for text messages to and from your clinical team.




Mobile@Work

MobileIron does not need to be used. It allows access work resources.




Phone

Allows for incoming and outgoing calls to your clinical team.




Photos
