




Data Update on Demographics and Actuarial Projections

Texas HIV Medication Program Fact Sheet January 1, 2021- March 31, 2021 Total Clients = 22,596




THMP Medications Ordered for Q1 2021





Budget Mitigation Details

Texas Administrative Code Rule, § 98.115, Texas HIV Medication Program Fiscal Planning

The TAC rule indicates cost containment measures that DSHS may implement to make certain that expenditures do not exceed the program's budget. The cost containment measures are:

- Initiate medical criteria to meet at minimum the most recent federal Department of Health and Human Services Guidelines for the Use of Antiretroviral Agents in HIV-Infected Adults and Adolescents
- Discontinue using the formula for adjusting the applicant's gross annual income
- Lower the financial eligibility criteria to a level not lower than 125% of federal poverty level.
- Cease enrollment of new applicants.



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
