This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of Clear Creek Brazoria, Galveston, and Harris Counties, Texas. Fish samples collected from Clear Creek indicate the presence of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) at concentrations exceeding health assessment guidelines established by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). Consumption of fish from Clear Creek may pose a threat to human health.

COUNTY: Brazoria, Galveston, and Harris Counties

AREA: Clear Creek upstream and west of Clear Lake

SPECIES AFFECTED: All fish species

CONSUMPTION ADVISORY: Persons should not consume any species of fish from these

waters.

This advisory shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified in writing.
