## FISH AND SHELLFISH CONSUMPTION ADVISORY

## ADV-44

This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of Mountain Creek Lake located in Dallas County, Texas within the Grand Prairie city limits. Channel catfish, common carp, freshwater drum, largemouth bass, smallmouth buffalo, and white bass samples collected from Mountain Creek Lake indicate the presence of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) at concentrations exceeding health assessment guidelines established by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). Consumption of fish from Mountain Creek Lake may pose a threat to human health.

COUNTY: Dallas

**AREA:** Mountain Creek Lake

**SPECIES AFFECTED:** All species of fish

**CONSUMPTION ADVISORY:** The DSHS advises that persons should not consume any

species of fish from these waters.

This advisory shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified in writing.
