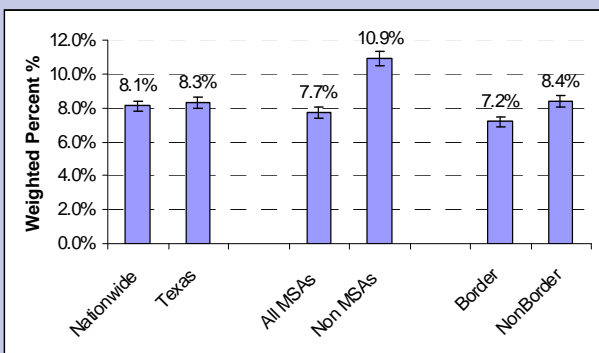


# Cardiovascular Disease in Texas

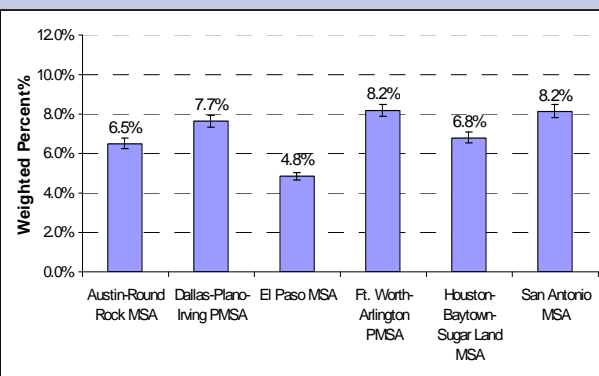
The approximate number of Texans who have one or more types of cardiovascular disease according to the current estimates (2007):

Cardiovascular Disease:	-	1,451,515	8.3%
Myocardial Infarction:	-	736,250	4.2%
Angina Pectoris:	-	772,975	4.4%
Stroke:	-	468,682	2.7%

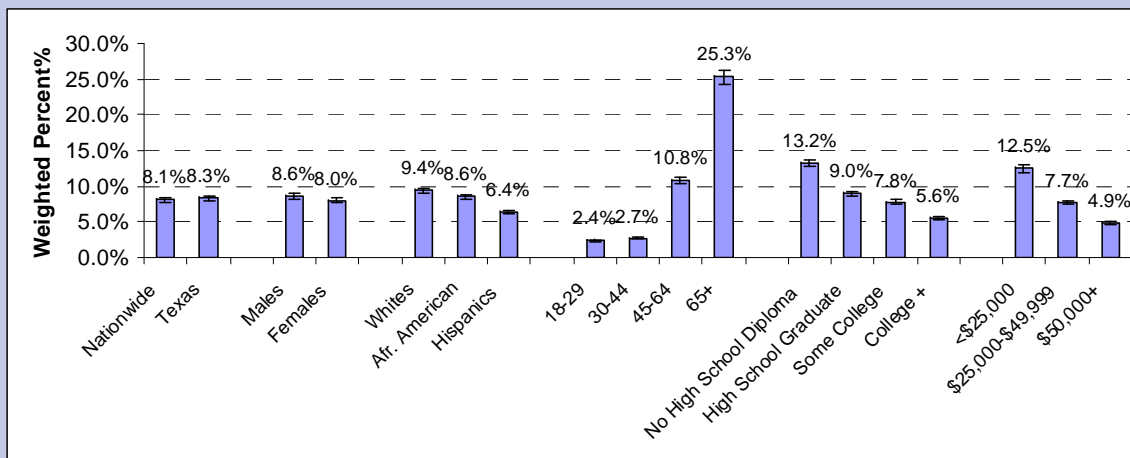
Prevalence of Cardiovascular Disease By Metropolitan Area, Border, and Non-Border, Texas 2007



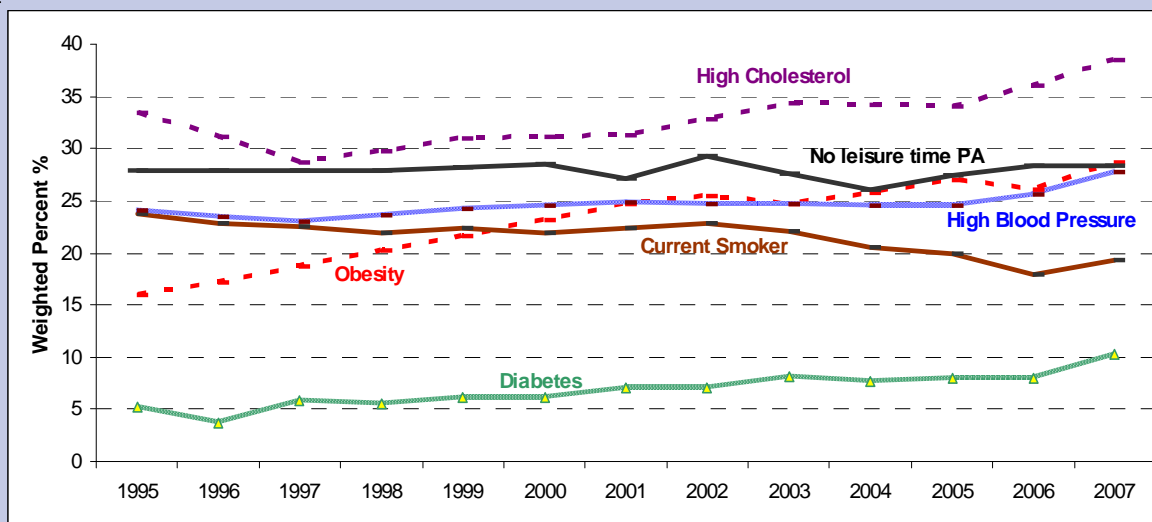
Prevalence of Cardiovascular Disease By Metropolitan Areas, Texas 2007

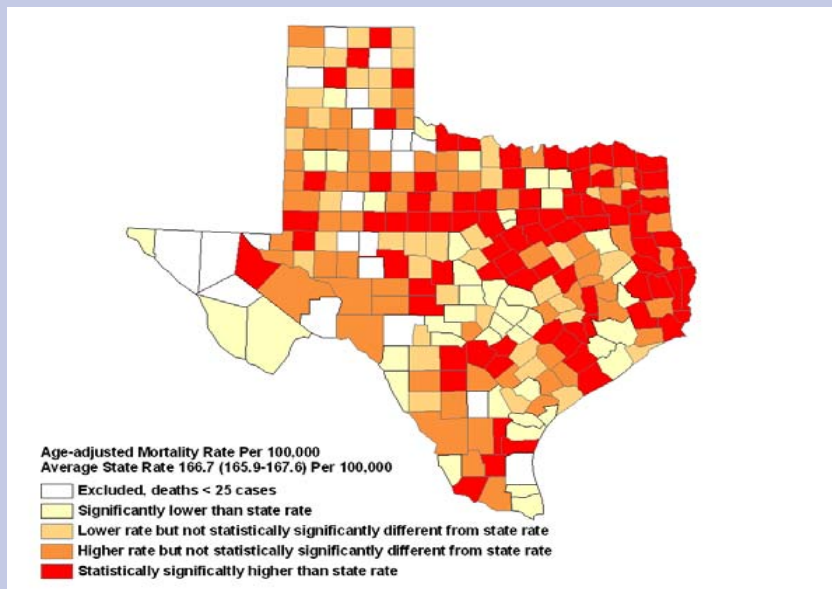

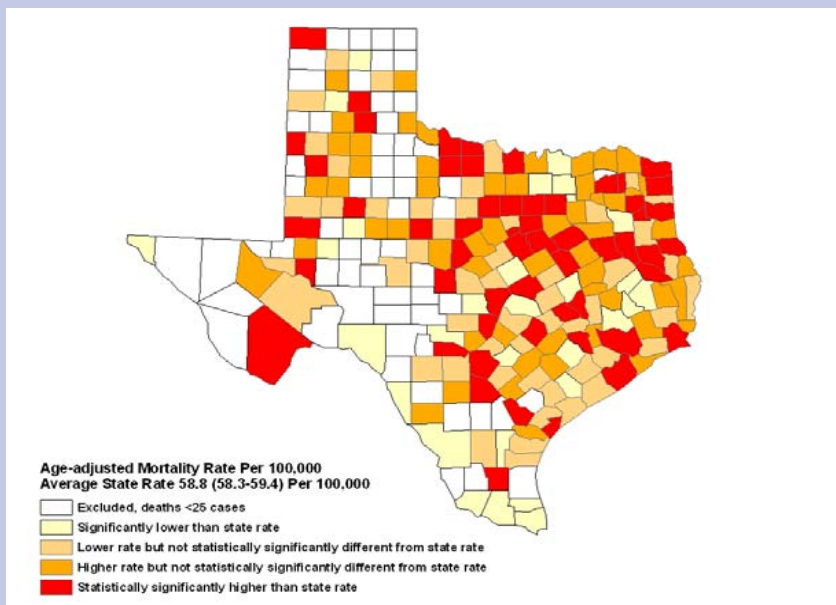
## Ischemic Heart Disease

5-year Average Age-Adjusted Mortality Rates Per 100,000, Texas



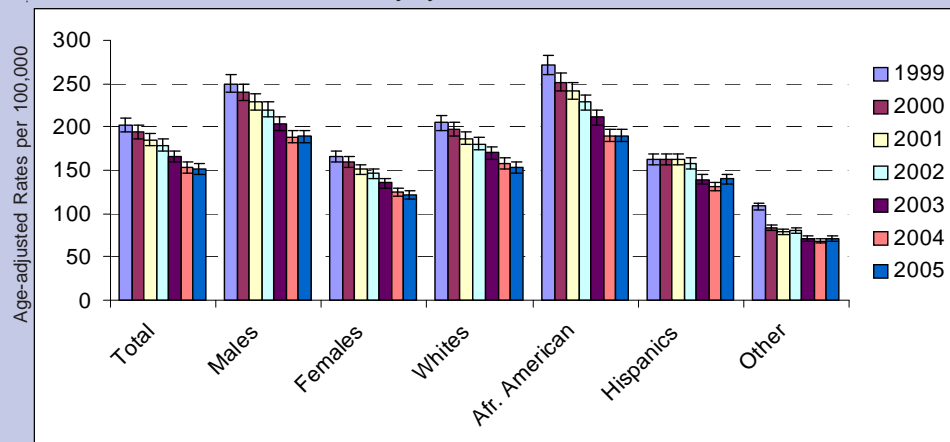

5-year Average Age-Adjusted Mortality Rates Per 100,000, Texas



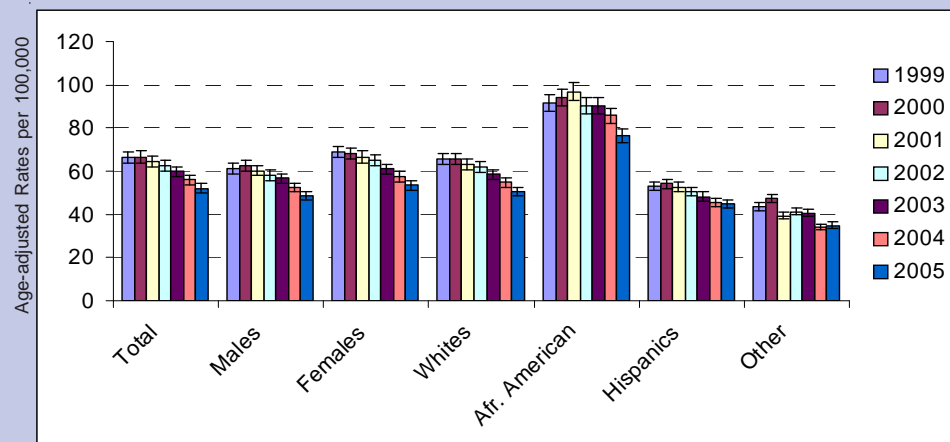
