## **Dental Assistants**

2014




In 2014, there were 31,791 actively licensed dental assistants (DA) providing care in Texas.

■ This number represented a 25.8% increase since 2011. Despite these improvements, Texas still had slightly fewer dental assistants than the national average.

- 72.0% of dental assistants were under 40 years of age.
- 22.3% of dental assistants were between 41 and 55 years of age.
- 5.7% of dental assistants will be at or past retirement age in ten years.
- In 2014, 94.2% of dental assistants were female and 5.8% were male.



## **Geographic Distribution of DAs**

Dental assistants were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 38.0% difference between the number of dental assistants in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 22.7%.
