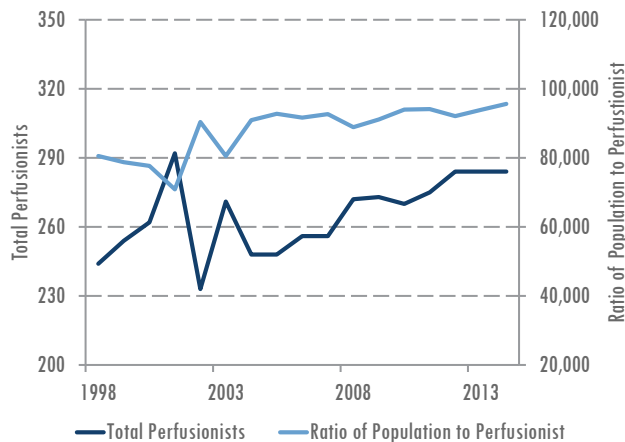

Perfusionist Growth Trends



In 2014, there were 284 active Perfusionists (PER) providing care in Texas.

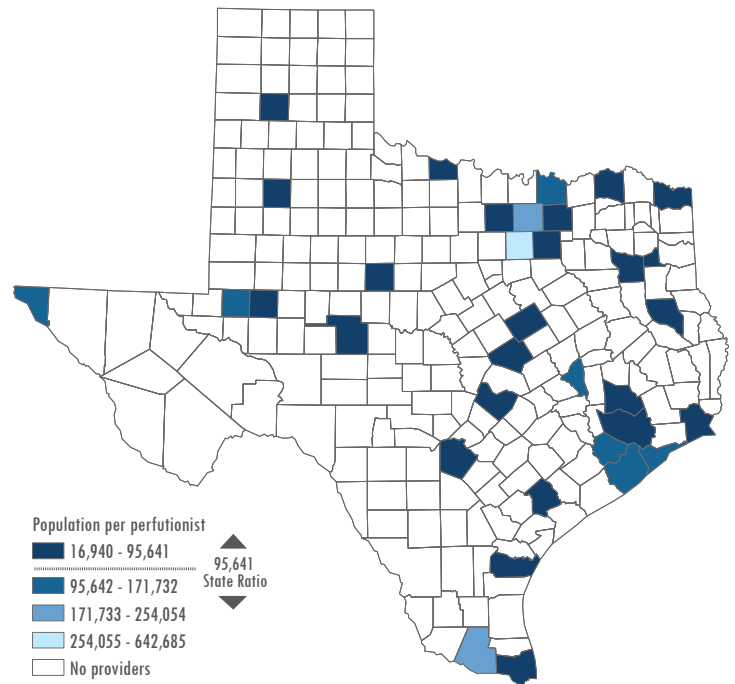
- This number represents a 4.0% increase since 2009 and a 14.5% increase since 2004.

Age Distribution of Perfusionists

- Only 2.5% of the current perfusionist workforce was eligible for retirement in 2014.
- Within ten years, 26.8% of the current perfusionist workforce will be at or past retirement age.
- 46.6% of the perfusionist workforce in 2014 was under 45 years of age.

Geographic Distribution of Perfusionists

Geographic Designation	Ratio of population to PER
Metropolitan	86,119
Non-metropolitan	626,931
Border	166,224
Non-border	66,311
Texas	95,641

- Perfusionists were not evenly distributed throughout the state.
- There was a 151.7% difference between the number of perfusionists in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
 - Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 85.9%.
