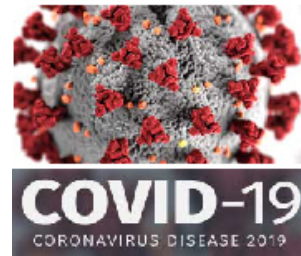

Beginning Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, providers may update their vaccine choice(s) within the Electronic Vaccine Inventory (EVI) system. In EVI, the "Update Choice" tab will become available **10 am on May 11, 2020**, and close at **3 pm on May 22, 2020**.

The next opportunity for providers to update their vaccine choice(s) will be **August 2020**.
