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# Registries Overview & Update

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- We have hired our new Trauma Registrar
  - Aisha Spinks
  - She will be assisting us in improving our data quality as well as bring the perspective of a certified trauma registrar to our Registry



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# NTDB Update

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- The major updates with NTDB 2017 include
  - Retiring of ICD-9 fields
  - New edit checks to assist with data quality
  - New data fields
  - New question package structure to match NTDB data dictionary



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# New NTDB 2017 data fields

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- Drug Screen (Page 72)
  - First recorded positive drug screen results within 24 hours after first hospital encounter
- Alcohol Screen (Page 73)
  - A Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) test was performed on the patient within 24 hours after first hospital encounter
- Alcohol Screen Results (Page 74)
  - First recorded BAC results within 24 hours after first hospital encounter
- National Provider Identifier (NPI) (Page 149)
  - The National Provider Identifier (NPI) of the admitting surgeon



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# New NTDB 2017 Resources

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- The new NTDB 2017 resources will be posted on our website as soon as we have a date to move to Production
- The resources include
  - NTDB 2017 Sample File
  - NTDB 2017 Data Dictionary
  - NTDB 2017 Data Dictionary (Tech Version)
  - NTDB 2017 XSD and Schematron
- We do not anticipate any changes to our custom elements



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# NEMESIS Update

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- Changed certain fields to direct entry only fields
- This change was made in order to reduce the maintenance burden of updating the relevant codes
  - We will accept any code that passes the NEMESIS validation for these fields



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# New Direct Entry Fields

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- The fields that were changed include
  - eScene.09 – ICD-10 Incident Location Type
  - eSituation.09 – Primary Symptom
  - eSituation.10 – Other Associated Symptoms
  - eSituation.11 – Provider's Primary Impression
  - eSituation.12 – Provider's Secondary Impression
  - eSituation.17 – Patient Activity
  - eInjury.01 – Cause of Injury
  - eHistory.08 – Medical / Surgical History
  - eHistory.12 – Current Medications



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# New Direct Entry Fields (cont.)

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- The fields that were changed include
  - eMedications.03 – Medication Given
  - eProcedures.03 – Procedure
  - eOutcome.10 – Emergency Department Diagnoses
  - eOutcome.12 – Hospital Procedures
  - eOutcome.13 – Hospital Diagnosis
  - eOutcome.08 – Emergency Department Recorded Cause of Injury
  - eOutcome.09 – Emergency Department Procedures
  - eHistory.06 – Medication Allergies



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# When will these new features be moving to Production?

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- We currently do not have a date as to when these new improvements will be moved to our Production system for our stakeholders to use
- Once we have a date we will send out a notice of the upcoming system maintenance to all of our users.
- Please ensure that your email is up to date in the Registry!!



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# Common Issues in the Registry

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- We have been seeing an influx of common issues related to data entry in the Registry
- These issues include
  - Not including DSHS ID on web-data entry records
  - Blank NTDB fields



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# Not including DSHS ID on web-data entry records

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- A DSHS ID must be included with each patient record in the Registry
- Failure to do so will result in your entity not receiving credit for that record
- This can impact EMS allotment funding at the end of the year.



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# Blank NTDB Fields

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- Every element in the NTDB data dictionary must be completed per the NTDB data dictionary
  - The only exception are the TQIP questions which are only to be completed by TQIP participating facilities
- Please ensure that your vendor is validating your files against the NTDB data dictionary before submitting to the Registry
- With the NTDB 2017 changes, we have enhanced our error checking technology to catch every error before submission
