

BLOOD WAS CAKED, CLOTTED, OR LAYERED ONTO THE FILTER PAPER

A heavy application of blood on the filter paper may result in false negative or false positive results. The below examples display some of the varying degrees of caking, clotting and layering.

These 3 specimens appear to have had a second application of blood on top of blood that had already dried

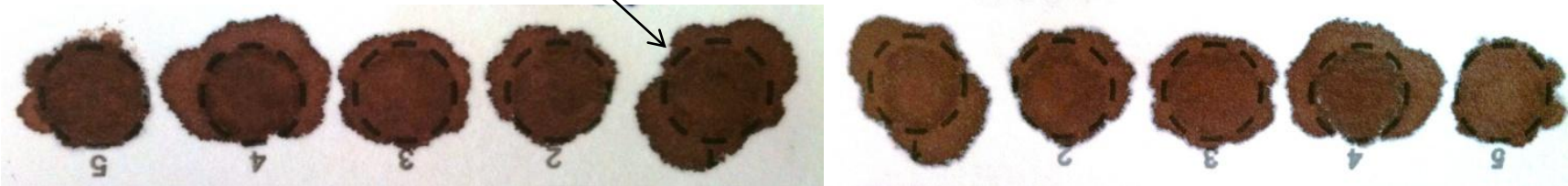
