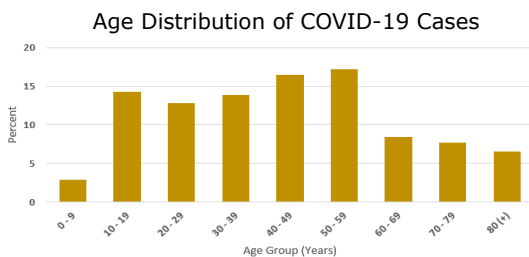
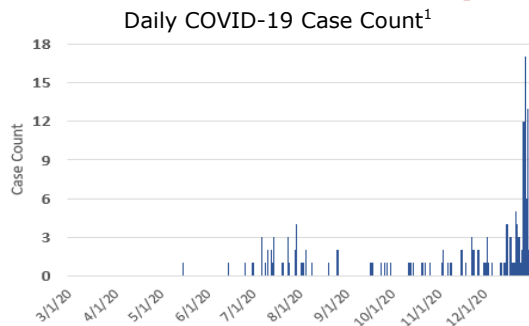
Region 8 Activities

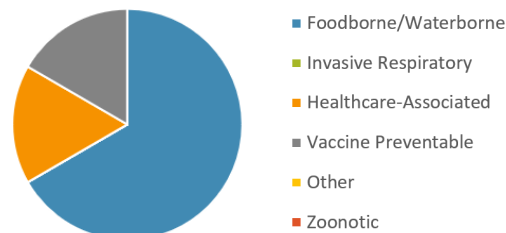
- The percent of school students with a conscientious exemption from immunizations filed at the school district level in Kinney County is 0.00% down from 0.18% in 2019
