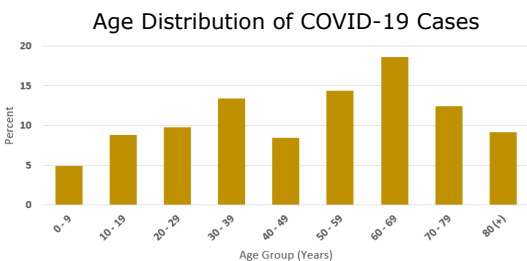
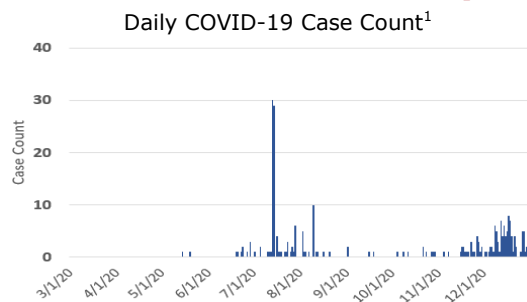
## Region 8 Activities

- Respond to COVID-19 through community education, monitoring patients, tracing contacts and serving on School Task Force
- Serve on the School Health Advisory Council (SHAC)
- Promote breastfeeding
- Distribute resources and educate providers about notifiable conditions and required reporting
- Send health advisories and updates about important health topics
- With area partners, educate community about safe sleep, breastfeeding and dangers of smoking during pregnancy
- Recruit and educate Texas Vaccines for Children providers
- Audit local schools and child care providers for compliance with immunization requirements
- Conduct healthcare provider visits, distribute resources, and educate providers on notifiable conditions and reporting requirements
