FISH AND SHELLFISH CONSUMPTION ADVISORY

ADV-33

This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of Fosdic Lake, Tarrant County. Common carp collected from Fosdic Lake indicate the presence of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) at concentrations exceeding health assessment guidelines established by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). Consumption of common carp from Fosdic Lake may pose a threat to human health.

**COUNTY:** Tarrant County


**AREA:** Fosdic Lake

**SPECIES AFFECTED:** Common carp

**CONSUMPTION ADVISORY:** The DSHS advises that adults should limit consumption of common carp to no more than two eight ounce meals per month and children under twelve years old should limit consumption common carp to no more than two four ounce meals per month. Women who are of childbearing age, who are or who might become pregnant, or who are nursing should not consume common carp from Fosdic Lake.

This advisory shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified in writing.
