

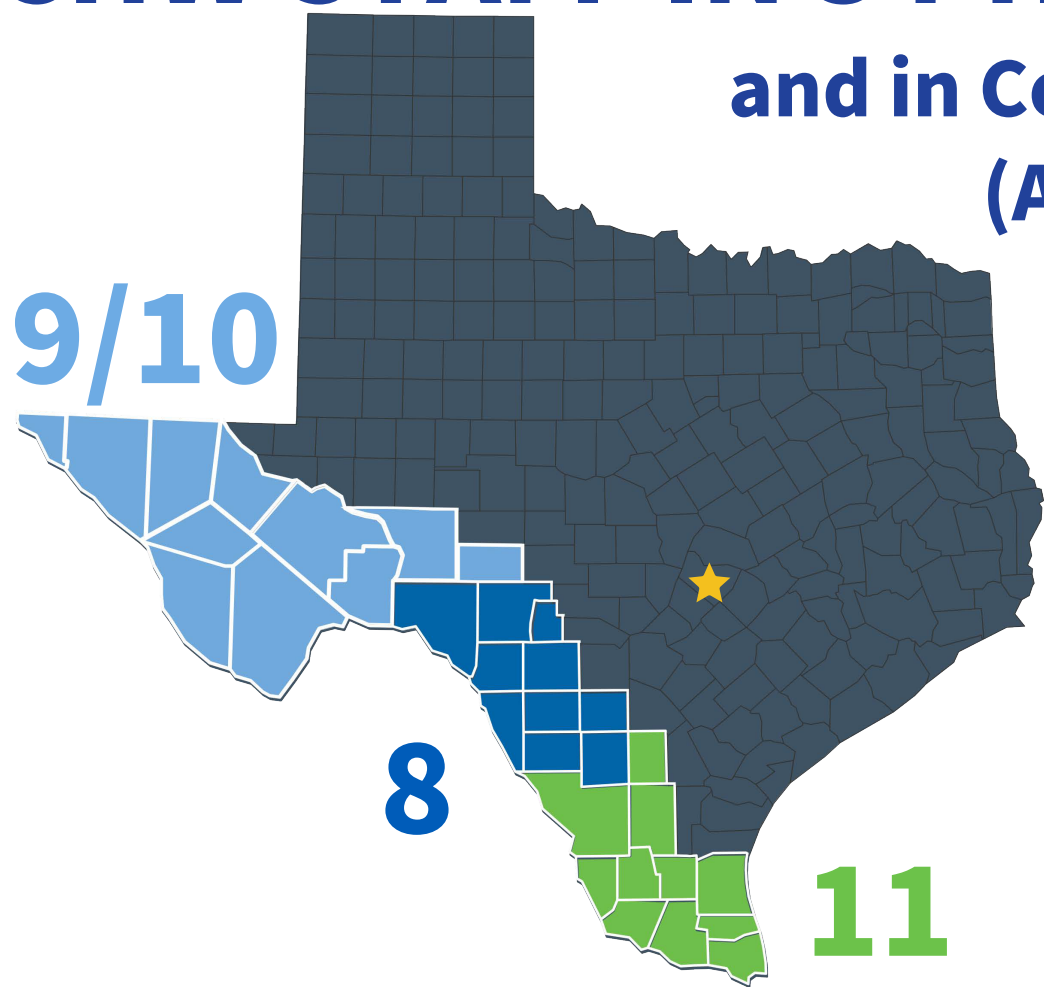
OBPH CHW TRAINING CENTER AT A GLANCE

CHWTC has been certified since 2017 by the DSHS CHW Training and Certification Program to provide Continuing Education Units (CEUs) for Community Health Workers (CHWs) and CHW Instructors (CHWIs).

Overall, the CHWTC has trained 4,544 CHWs and CHWIs, and 1,334 non-CHWs/CHWIs.

CHWs and CHWIs must earn 20 CEUs to be recertified every 2 years.

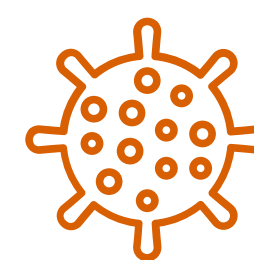
