In 2017, 161 correctional facilities met the Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 89 criteria and were required to report their TB screening activities in the form of a Monthly Correctional TB Report. This annual report highlights TB screening activities in your jail and compares results to all designated Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 89 correctional facilities.

In 2017, there were 2,448 inmate tuberculin skin tests administered and read at El Paso County Annex. Of that number, 167 (10.7%) had a measurement of 10 mm or greater.
