


Required Risk Adjusted Benchmarking

American College of Surgeons (ACS)

ACS (Gray Book) Requires

- ACS Resources for Optimal Care of the Injured Patient 2022 (Gray Book)
 - ALL Level I, II, and III verified trauma centers must participate in a risk adjusted benchmarking program
 - The centers MUST USE the RESULTS to determine whether there are opportunities for improvement in patient care and registry data quality



WHY PARTICIPATE IN TQIP?

Benchmarking

TQIP offers access to detailed data with blinded benchmarking against other facilities at state and national levels

Allows you to compare your program with like facilities nationally

Provides comparison with Texas TQIP Collaborative facilities




Benchmarking

- Spring and Fall Benchmark Reports
 - Validated risk adjusted benchmarking provides comparison of:
 - Patient Care
 - Outcomes
 - Process Measure Reviews



Benchmarking

 Review of outliers enables programs to do a deeper dive for greater opportunities for improvement



Process Improvement



TQIP Benchmark reports help drive PI and process outcome focus areas



Review of reports with team and stakeholders provides a greater understanding of the impact of PI process

TQIP can be utilized to confirm improvements made in your program




Reports facilitate multi-specialty involvement in your PI program



Data Quality

- Review of TQIP reports with team and stakeholders
 - Allows for a greater understanding of the impact of the registry data quality
- Helps to focus your data
- Data quality reports provide external data validation
 - Measure accuracy
 - Address quality of abstracting



Data Quality

- Helps your facility see how data is affected by
 - Documentation
 - Abstracting
 - Validation
 - Dashboards
 - Benchmarking

 - Great way to improve or energize engagement in your program




Networking and Growth Development
