How do I care for microfiber towels?

You can use your microfiber towel hundreds of times. Follow these easy steps to help your towels last.

- 1. Always wash your microfiber towels separately. Lint from other clothes will reduce absorbency of your microfiber towels.
- 2. Only use detergent. Fabric softener will reduce absorbency.
- 3. Wash in warm water to remove germs and dirt.
- 4. Let the towels air dry if possible for the greatest absorbency.

Make Microfiber Towels Work for You

- Microfiber towels easily pick up dust and dirt prior to sanitizing and disinfecting. There's no need to buy special disposable dusters.
- Use your microfiber towels with soap and water to scrub grimy messes. This creates less waste than using multiple paper towels.
- Use towels to clean up spills. They are more absorbent than paper or other cloth towels.
