The Future is Now: Advances in HIV Prevention and Treatment in 2024



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Dr. Barbara Taylor is a Professor of Infectious Diseases and the Assistant Dean for the MD/MPH Program at UT Health San Antonio. Dr. Taylor conducts research to improve health outcomes for those living with or at risk for HIV, with a specific focus on Latinx populations, and is an infectious disease specialist with a focus on care of people living with HIV and other viral illnesses. Her current work uses implementation science to address barriers to care for emerging adults with HIV in South Texas and explores risk for STIs in key populations in the Dominican Republic. She is also a principal investigator on the NIH-funded RECOVER study, which works to determine the impact of Post-Acute Sequelae of SARS-CoV-2 Infection, or long COVID.
