Can a RW Provider Provide Any Services to Incarcerated Clients?

Ryan White funded agencies can provide core medical and support services to an incarcerated client on a transitional basis (up to 180 days). This is as long as the services are in areas that are not expected to be covered by the incarceration facility (no duplication of services).
