Programmatic News Flash

1. Health Resources and Services Administration's HIV/AIDS Bureau (HRSA HAB) Policy Clarification Notices

- PCN #15-02, Clinical Quality Management, revises the number of performance measures a recipient must have for each funded service category based on the number of clients served in a category to reduce burden for recipients.
 PCN #15-02, Clinical Quality Management (Updated)
- PCN #18-02 replaces PCN #07-04, The Use of Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Funds for Transitional Social Support and Primary Care Services for Incarcerated Persons. This PCN provides guidance on the use of program funds to provide core medical services and support services on a transitional basis to people living with HIV (PLWH) who are incarcerated in Federal and State prison systems. It also clarifies that recipients can use RWHAP funds for core medical services and support services on a short-term and/or transitional basis to PLWH who are incarcerated in certain correctional systems (e.g., local prisons or jails) or under community supervision (e.g., parole or home detention).

4. Triage Guidelines

• The position of the Texas Board of Nurse Examiners is that only RN's have the skill set and the knowledge to safely assess a client's symptoms and help determine the cue in triage scenario. The Board is aware that LVNs may practice in: physician's offices, or other similar settings. In settings where a physician is present, there may be a set of standardized guidelines approved by the physician to establish treatment priorities within the office environment under the supervision of the physician.
