THMP will continue to accept both existing and new application materials until **July 1, 2020**.

### 5. Prevention of Disease and Illness through Vaccine Administration

The following vaccines are available to all Texas Ryan White Part-B
Outpatient Ambulatory Health Services providers free of charge through the
Adult Safety Net (ASN) Program:

ASN Available Vaccines
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Hepatitis A vaccine
Hepatitis B vaccine
Combination hepatitis A-hepatitis B vaccine
Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine
Measles, mumps, & rubella (MMR) vaccine
Meningococcal vaccine
Pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPSV23)
Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13)
Tetanus, diphtheria, & pertussis (Tdap) vaccine
Tetanus-diphtheria (Td) vaccine
Varicella vaccine
Zoster vaccine

- The ASN program allows for a \$25.00 administration charge per vaccine, which can be billed to the Texas Ryan White Part B & State Services contracts as a line item in ARIES to cover the cost of staff and supplies.
