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WHICH TEST?	HOW DO THEY TEST FOR IT?	HOW DO I KNOW IF I NEED THE TEST?	HOW OFTEN SHOULD I GET TESTED?	
HIV	Blood	lf your last test was negative or you've never been tested.	At least annually, or every three to six months if you have more than one sex partner	
Syphilis	Blood	A must for sexually active gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men (MSM).		
Gonorrhea and Chlamydia of the throat	Throat swab	lf you perform oral sex.		
Gonorrhea and Chlamydia of the rectum (butt)	Rectal (butt) swab	lf you receive (bottom) during anal sex.		/
Gonorrhea and Chlamydia of the urethra (penis)	Urine screening	lf you give (top) during anal sex or receive oral sex.		
Hepatitis C	Blood	If you are living with HIV, born between 1945 and 1965, or have shared injection drug equipment.
