THMP Emergency Application

- The Emergency Application started March 13, 2020:
 - ➤ 2-pages and for all applications types
 - Supporting documents are requested but not required
- Clients who do not recertify or complete the self-attestation will have their eligibility automatically extended to 12/31/2020

 Emergency application and guidance applies to both Ryan White Part B Care Services and THMP (expect automatic extensions)

Reminders for Emergency Applications

- Client's that have not been in contact with the program since February:
 - ➤ Will first be mailed another application as a reminder
 - ➤ Will be outreached by THMP via phone to complete an application over the phone
- The emergency application will be in place until December 31, 2020, however continued extensions depend if Texas is still in a state of emergency



THMP Medications-COVID Response

- Clients may continue to order up to 20 days before they run out of medication
- For 30-day fills THMP is still sending a two-month supply for most medications
- THMP also encourages clients to inquire if their pharmacy can deliver their medications
- If the client's pharmacy cannot deliver medications, clients can contact the program to request to move to mail order if they desire



Staffing-COVID Response

- Many staff are now WFH
- Faxes are now received electronically.
- Phones are still available.
- Program has daily morning meetings at 9:00 am

Texas ADAP Medication Interface

- Program staff are using TAMI starting 9/21/2020
- This is an improved database until the larger HRAR project is implemented.
- Please be patient as we learn the new system.



THMP Medications Check the MCF



Why should you check the MCF for a patient not changing medications?

- The MAC now has a formulary subcommittee
- New medications are now available for mental health, cardiovascular, diabetes and other co-occurring issues.
- Many medications are now available as 90 day fills with provider authorization.
