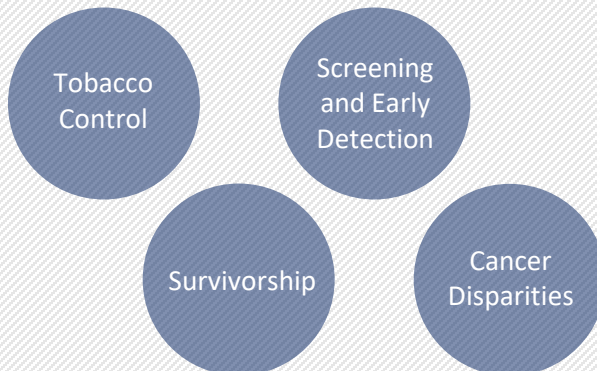
A comprehensive cancer control coalition working to reduce the burden of cancer in Texas
